Saluda School District estimate is based on a two-year growth rate from FY 2014-15 to FY 2016-17 due to the significant increase in the number of pupils in FY 2015-16. Actual ADMs may vary for FY 2017-18. The FY 2017-18 estimate for the Public Charter District was provided by the Department of Education.
