


SOUTHEASTERN AVERAGE TEACHER SALARY

Estimates for FY 1995-96 to FY 2015-16




SOUTHEASTERN AVERAGE TEACHER SALARY


Estimates for FY 2008-09 to FY 2015-16

ISSUES REGARDING THE SOUTHEASTERN AVERAGE TEACHER SALARY

- Data from several states show that average teacher salaries are not increasing as fast as predicted in earlier years
- Slower growth due to:
 - Recession
 - Higher than normal retirement rates
 - Elimination of incentives for advanced degrees
- Budget projections and SREB reports for several Southeastern states suggest growth for future years at one to two percent
- Prior to the recent recession, growth rates were two and a half percent to four percent


