### **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill is not expected to have an expenditure impact on the Election Commission, as processing registrations, applications and absentee votes is a part of the normal course of business.

### **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

#### **Introduced on January 8, 2019**

##### **State Expenditure**

This bill requires voter registrations, applications, and absentee voting to be submitted within twenty days before the election. Currently, voter registrations, applications, and absentee voting may be submitted within thirty days before the election. This bill shortens the gap between the application, registration, or absentee vote and the election by ten days.

This bill is not expected to have an expenditure impact on the Election Commission, as processing registrations, applications, and absentee votes is a part of the normal course of business.
