This bill is not expected have a local expenditure impact because the number of managers chairmen, and clerks appointed for an election has not been modified.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill requires all clerks and chairman appointed from the managers of election for the various polling places in the state to be a resident and a registered elector of the respective county in which they are appointed to work or in an adjoining county. Previously, a manager must be a resident and registered elector in the respective county in which he is appointed to work or an adjoining county.

This bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact on the Election Commission because there is no change to the agency's responsibilities.

Local Expenditure

This bill requires all clerks and chairman appointed from the managers of election for the various polling places in the state to be a resident and a registered elector of the respective county in which they are appointed to work or in an adjoining county. Previously, a manager must be a resident and registered elector in the respective county in which he is appointed to work or an adjoining county.

This bill does not modify the number of clerks, chairmen, or managers of an election that must be appointed. Therefore, there is no anticipated increase to local expenditures due to this bill.
