**BILL SUMMARY:**

House Bill 3091, as amended, amends Section 33-56-55 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended, by providing an exemption to an athletic, band, or other extracurricular activity booster club or organization affiliated with a K-12 school from filing a registration statement with the Secretary of State if the organization is a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt entity properly filing all required federal and state reporting forms.

**EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:**

Secretary of State's Office

The Office reports this Bill would create an estimated cost to Other Funds of \$4,250 as a result of exempting 85 school districts from filing registration statements. The Office reports this cost could be absorbed within the agency's current level of funding.
