BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 3099 amends Section 63-17-2310, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to entities required to provide information to the Department of Social Services for the purpose of establishing, modifying, and enforcing child support obligations, so as to also require these entities to provide this information to clerks of court for the same purpose in cases not being administered pursuant to Title IV-D of the Social Security Act by the Department of Social Services; and to make technical corrections.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

The Department of Social Services estimates that this Bill will have no fiscal impact on the State General Fund or on Federal and/or Other Funds.
