BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 3148 amends Section 40-7-20, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to definition of hair braiding, so as to include the use of artificial hair. This Bill also amends Section 40-7-350, relating to barber education, so as to provide that a school offering hair braiding coursework must be registered with the Board and the instructor be licensed as a hair braider by the Board. Further, the Bill amends Section 40-7-255, relating to hair braiding education requirements, so as to increase the education requirements for licensure.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

The Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation estimates this Bill will have no fiscal impact on the State General Fund or on Federal and/or Other Funds.
