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**BILL SUMMARY:**

House Bill 3366 amends Chapter 66, Title 44 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 44-66-75 which requires health care providers to provide a patient with the opportunity to (1) authorize the release of specified information concerning the patient and his treatment to family members and other individuals designated by the patient; and (2) authorize specified individuals to be involved in the patient's treatment. The Bill provides guidelines related to the formal authorization by each patient. The Bill further amends Section 44-66-20 by adding definitions for "patient" and "treatment."
