**BILL SUMMARY:**

House Bill 3369 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 42-1-378 so as to provide that an employee covered by the Federal Employers' Liability Act, the Longshore and Harbor Workers' Compensation Act or any of its extensions, or the Jones Act is exempt from workers' compensation laws.
