BILL SUMMARY:

This Bill would amend Section 59-63-30, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by eliminating the provision allowing a child to qualify for attendance in a public school district if he owns real estate in the district having an assessed value of three hundred dollars or more.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

The State Department of Education projects no fiscal impact to the agency if the bill is enacted.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT IMPACT:

By eliminating the provision, funds would be reallocated between school districts. A student who is currently enrolled in a school district because they have property in their name would have to enroll in another school district.
