BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 3409 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 40-59-25 so as to prohibit certain acts by residential builders or contractors relating to roofing systems. The Bill also amends Section 40-59-110, relating to revocation, suspension, or restriction of the license by the residential home builders commission, so as to provide a conforming change.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:
