State Expenditure

The bill amends Section 59-39-115 to issue high school diplomas to Korean War Veterans and Vietnam Veterans with proof of school enrollment and a copy of a DD-214.

The State Department of Education indicates this bill would have no expenditure impact to General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds. The local school districts would be required to pay \$1 for each diploma and public outreach costs which can be absorbed within current appropriations.
