BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 3572 amends multiple Chapters of Title 59 pertaining to the Boards of Trustees of certain four-year institutions by inserting language which adds one member to the Boards of Trustees of each institution and provides for the manner of appointment.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

Commission on Higher Education

Based on the colleges' and universities' individual responses to the Commission on Higher Education survey, the legislation, if enacted, would have a minimal impact. Costs are associated with expenditures necessary to cover allowable obligations including per diem and it is anticipated that costs could be absorbed.
