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**BILL SUMMARY:**

House Bill 3631, as Amended, amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 56-3-115 which provides for the issuance of Golf Cart Permits in order to regulate the operations of Golf Carts and provides penalties for violations of this code. This Bill also repeals Section 56-2-105.
