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**BILL SUMMARY:**

House Bill 3822, as Amended, amends various sections of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, dealing with concealed weapons permits, by eliminating definitions like, “Resident”, “Qualified Non-Resident”, “Proof of Residence”, and various other terms. The Bill increases the application fee for the concealed weapons permit to seventy-five dollars and also creates a non-resident application fee of seventy-five dollars and allows the permit to be submitted electronically to SLED.

**EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:**

The Division indicates that this Bill will have no fiscal impact on the General Fund of the State, nor on Federal and/or Other Funds. The increase in the application fee would cover any additional costs associated with the new notification requirements of the Bill.
