BILL SUMMARY:

This Bill, as Amended, would amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976 by adding Section 59-40-111 to authorize an Alternative Education Campus (AEC) to be established by a Charter School sponsor in order to serve a specific student population. Additionally, it would provide the criteria for a charter school to be designated as an AEC and amend applicable Sections establishing Charter Schools.
