BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 3908 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Article 132 to Chapter 3 of Title 56 which provides that the Department of Motor Vehicles may issue special personalized motor vehicle license plates establishing a fee structure and how the plate will be displayed. The Bill also amends Sections 56-3-2250, 56-3-8000 and 56-3-8100 by requiring the Department of Motor Vehicles to make a basic license plate design for all special organizational license plates to be issued for all organizational license plate requests.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:
