### **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill will have no impact on the Governor's Office General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds, as the Governor's appointment of a State Surgeon General (Surgeon General) will be conducted in the course of agency business.

### **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

#### **Introduced on April 2, 2019**

#### **State Expenditure**

This bill provides for the appointment of a Surgeon General by the Governor for a four-year term. This bill tasks the Surgeon General with:

- advising the Governor on a comprehensive approach to addressing lifestyle health risks and challenges facing the State;
- participating on relevant task forces, initiatives, collaboratives, and public programming at the request of the Governor; and
- preparing an annual report for the Governor and General Assembly, which provides evidence-based recommendations on how to promote healthy lifestyles throughout the State.

This bill also creates an advisory committee to support the work of the State Surgeon General. Committee members will not be entitled to per diem, mileage, and subsistence.

This bill will not have an impact on the Governor's Office General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds, as committee members are not entitled to per diem, mileage, and subsistence. The Governor's appointment of the Surgeon General will be conducted in the course of agency business.
