**Explanation of Amended Bill as Signed by the Governor on June 22, 2016**

**State Expenditure**

The amended bill creates a seven-member Brain Tissue Donor Study Committee charged with providing a process and procedure for a person's brain tissue to be donated for research and education. Members of the committee are to serve without compensation. Staff support is provided by the Senate and House of Representatives. The committee is required to submit a report to the General Assembly by December 31, 2016, at which time the committee shall dissolve.

Since members shall serve without mileage, per diem, or subsistence, this bill would have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.
