House Bill 4471 amends Section 40-47-117 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, regarding investigations by the Board of Medical Examiners into allegations of professional misconduct, so as to provide that a certified report of proceedings by a panel of the Board be made available to the public when filed with the Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation.
