BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 4560, as amended, amends Section 17-1-40 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the destruction or Expungement of arrest and booking records under certain circumstances, by providing that the retention of evidence gathered, incident reports and investigative files produced as a result of a law enforcement action not be subject to an Expungement order and authorized redaction of certain information following a no conviction disposition of the criminal charge.
