**BILL SUMMARY:**

House Bill 4604 amends Section 40-22-280, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to exemptions from the licensure requirement to practice engineering, so as to provide an exemption for certain activities performed by full-time employees or other personnel of a manufacturing company, and to define necessary terms.

**EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:**

The Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation estimates this Bill will have a minimal cost on the State General Fund but can be absorbed by the agency.
