BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 4630 amends Section 23-23-60 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as it relates to the expiration or lapse of the Law Enforcement Certification of an officer upon his discontinuance of employment by providing an exemption when the employment is discontinued due to an absence from work due to a disability sustained in that employment for which he receives workers compensation benefits and has not been authorized to return to work.
