Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill adds continuing education requirements to licensees of the Board of Cosmetology, which is under the regulation of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation (LLR). The bill requires the department to perform activities that will be conducted in the normal course of agency business and will have no impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill requires the following persons licensed by LLR's Board of Cosmetology (board) to successfully complete three hours of instruction in regulations, health, safety, and sanitation during the preceding licensing year:

- cosmetologists
- nail technicians
- estheticians
- instructors of the above licensees

These hours may only be obtained from providers approved by the board. It also requires instructors to successfully complete three hours of teaching methodology taught by any professional. The bill requires the department to perform activities that will be conducted in the normal course of agency business and will have no impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.
