The Bill would amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 59-63-97 so to authorize certain school personnel to administer midazolam intranasally to students with a seizure condition and to provide for immunity from liability with regard to administration of midazolam.

The State Department of Education and the Department of Health and Environmental Control report that this Bill would have minimal impact on the agencies that would be absorbed by using existing resources.


