### **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill allows a parent or legal guardian of a child with a serious illness to request a “do not resuscitate order for emergency services” (DNR Order) for the child. This bill will have no expenditure impact on the Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) because the agency will administer policies resulting from the bill with the use of existing staff and resources.

### **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

#### **Introduced on February 5, 2020**

#### **State Expenditure**

This bill allows a parent or legal guardian of a child with a serious illness to request a DNR Order, provided they have legal authority to make medical decisions for the child. In addition, the bill defines “serious illness” as a condition which is likely to result in death within a period of twelve months or less. Currently, state law prohibits a person under the age of eighteen from requesting or receiving a DNR Order. The DNR Order form is maintained by DHEC. This bill will require DHEC to update this form online.

DHEC indicates that the requirements of this bill will be implemented using existing staff and resources. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the agency.
