BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 151 amends Section 56-1-2080 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the qualifications for a Commercial Driver's License, by establishing the Intrastate Vision Waiver Program. This Program would allow certain visually impaired individuals to obtain a waiver from the sight requirements associated with the Commercial Driver's License.
