Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on January 10, 2017

State Expenditure

This bill directs that the Director of the Department of Disabilities and Special Needs (DDSN) shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate. Previously, the director was appointed by the commission. The South Carolina Commission on Disabilities and Special Needs will now be an advisory board to DDSN. The director may appoint additional advisory committees he considers necessary and may appoint and remove officers and employees of DDSN at his discretion. The director has the final authority over applicant eligibility, determination, or services and admission orders.

Department of Disabilities and Special Needs. The department indicates this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds, as a change in governance structure does not create any additional cost to the administration or operation of the agency.
