BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 239 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, to propose an amendment to the Constitution of South Carolina relating to the prohibition on lotteries and the exceptions to this prohibition. The proposed amendment must be submitted to the qualified electors at the next general election.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

The State Election Commission reports that this Bill would require a referendum on the ballot and the cost would be covered with funds appropriated for statewide elections.
