### **Fiscal Impact Summary**

### **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

#### **Introduced on January 8, 2019**

##### **State Expenditure**

This bill amends the Uniform Athlete Agents Act of 2018 to allow certified athlete agents to pay certain expenses incurred before agency contracts are signed. The Department of Consumer Affairs indicates they do not anticipate any expenditure impact because the department already regulates athlete agents and this bill mainly offers an exception to current regulations dictating athlete agent conduct. Therefore, this bill does not have an expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.
