Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds, because the bill will have no effect on the processing of registrations. The bill extends the time period an unregistered security officer is permitted to perform security related duties while awaiting the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division’s (SLED) registration approval.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Signed by Governor on February 12, 2018

State Expenditure

Under previous law, a security officer that is awaiting approval for registration from SLED is permitted to perform the duties of a security officer for up to twenty days after SLED’s receipt of the officer’s application for registration. The bill extends the time period an unregistered security officer awaiting SLED’s registration approval may perform security officer duties to thirty days after SLED’s receipt of the registration application. Security officers waiting for approval may not carry a firearm or exercise arrest authority.

State Law Enforcement Division. The department reports that the bill will have no effect on the processing of security officer registrations and will therefore result in no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.
