Senate Bill 445 amends Section 25-1-320 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended to require that an Adjutant General be appointed by the Governor upon the advice and consent of the Senate. The Bill provides for the terms of office and addresses the minimum qualifications of the individual appointed to serve as Adjutant General.
