Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill would have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill amends Section 59-32-30(A) to add a requirement that students receive family relationship instruction each year to include the topic of domestic violence in grades five through eight. School districts must adopt a mandatory attendance policy for family relationship instruction. In addition, the Department of Social Services is directed to approve any organization which conducts domestic violence intervention programs on school premises.

The State Department of Education. The department indicates there are several references to domestic violence in the 2009 Academic Standards for Health and Safety Education at both the Middle and High school levels. Therefore, there is no expenditure impact to the department or local school districts.

Department of Social Services. The department indicates this bill would have a minimal expenditure impact which can be absorbed within current appropriations.
