**BILL SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 552 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Chapter 33 to Title 33, so as enact the "Revised Uniform Unincorporated Nonprofit Association Act", to among other things, define terms, specify applicability, set forth powers of the unincorporated nonprofit associations, to specify liability, and to set forth the process by which a legal action against an association is adjudicated.

**EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:**

The Office of the Secretary of State estimates enactment of this Bill would have a minimal impact on the agency that could be absorbed within the current level of funding.
