BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 841 amends Article 1, Chapter 13, Title 63, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the regulation of childcare facilities, by adding section 63-13-185, so as to prohibit the administration of medication to a child by an employee or volunteer of a childcare facility without parental permission, and to include exceptions in circumstances of emergencies, and to provide penalties.
