State Expenditure

This bill requires DHEC to update its video presentation related to the care of infants and young children. DHEC is currently developing an updated version of this video and will use this opportunity to include the information required by this bill. Related expenses for this video are funded by the Federal Maternal and Child Health Title V Block Grant, which was previously secured by DHEC. Therefore, this portion of the bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.

In addition, this bill requires DHEC to update the protocol for health care providers to include educating parents and primary caregivers about safe sleep practices and Sudden Unexpected Infant Death Syndrome. DHEC indicates that this new responsibility will be managed by existing staff. Therefore, this portion of the bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.
