**Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill extends the time for which the responsibilities of the Denmark Technical College Area Commission (Denmark Commission) are transferred to the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education (State Board) by two months, from November 1, 2018, to January 1, 2019. As the Denmark Commission will continue to exist and will meet for the purpose of providing input to the State Board, the bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds of Denmark Technical College.

The State Board plans to address its temporary duties from the Denmark Commission using existing appropriations and staff. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds of the State Board.

**Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

**Signed by Governor on May 3, 2018**

**State Expenditure**

Act 56 of 2017 devolved the responsibilities of the existing Denmark Commission upon the State Board for an eighteen month period, beginning May 1, 2017, and ending November 1, 2018. On November 1, 2018, all responsibilities were scheduled to revert back from the State Board to the Denmark Commission. This bill extends the time for which the responsibilities of the Denmark Commission are transferred to the State Board by two months, from November 1, 2018, to January 1, 2019. The required reporting associated with this transfer is also extended. Act 56 of 2017 as enacted had no expenditure or revenue impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.

**State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education.** The State Board indicates that the additional responsibilities of assuming all powers, duties, and obligations vested in the Denmark Commission can be managed within its existing appropriations. Extending the time period by two months will not impact the State Board's ability to manage these responsibilities. Therefore, this bill will not impact General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds expenditures of the State Board.

**Denmark Technical College.** The Denmark Commission will continue to meet to provide input to the State Board. As a result, Denmark Technical College expects no savings from the temporary transfer of the Denmark Commission's responsibilities. Therefore, this bill will not impact General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds expenditures of Denmark Technical College.
