**BILL SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 1070 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 109763, by adding Section 50-11-525 which allows the Department of Natural Resources the authority to disseminate the regulations governing the hunting of Wild Turkeys. The Bill further amends Section 50-11-520, 50-11-530, 50-11-540 and 50-11-544 all related to DNR's regulation of hunting of Wild Turkeys so as to allow the agency to revise seasons and to establish, "South Carolina Youth Turkey Hunt Day".


