Fiscal Impact Summary

State Expenditure

This bill amends the Amusement Rides Safety Code to lower the age of a person allowed to operate super-karts at carnivals, fairs, and amusement parks from eighteen to fifteen. The operator must hold a regular driver's license, conditional driver's license, or special restricted driver's license. LLR's Office of Elevators and Amusement Rides administers the Amusement Rides Safety Code and Regulations. The agency indicates that the bill does not operationally or fiscally impact LLR. Therefore, there is no expenditure impact to the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.
