The Bill would amend Article 3, Chapter 10, Title 59 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 59-10-310 to define "In-School Fundraiser," to amend Section 59-10-310 and 59-10-330(B) relating to the compliance with federal standards.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:
