**BILL SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 1096 amends Section 50-5-1705 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to fish catch limits, by adding item (J) declaring it unlawful for one person to possess in any one day more than forty-five of a combination of spot, whiting and Atlantic croaker.
