Bill Summary

To amend Section 56-1-148 of the 1976 Code, relating to the identifying code affixed on the driver's license of a person convicted of certain crimes, to remove the fifty dollar fee associated with the identifying code.

REVENUE IMPACT ^{1/}

This bill would reduce the Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV) Other Fund revenue by approximately \$100,000 annually. There is no impact on the General Fund of the State.

Explanation

Based on information obtained from DMV, removing the \$50 convicted violent offender fee would reduce DMV's Other Fund revenue by approximately \$100,000 annually. There is no impact on the General Fund of the State.
