Introduction

Proviso 1.3 of the annual Appropriations Act requires the Revenue and Fiscal Affairs Office (RFA) to post in a prominent place on its website for each school district projections, including per pupil state, federal and local revenues, excluding revenues of local bond issues, for the current fiscal year. The FY 2024-25 report has been updated to include estimates for ESSER funds for FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25 and to update the pupil count to the 45-day student count for FY 2024-25.

Data and Methodology

- Revenues exclude intergovernmental revenues (codes: 2000s), interfund transfers (codes: 5200s), revenues from the sale of bonds and long-term notes (codes: 5100s and 5400), and lease purchase revenue (codes 5500, 5600). Other state property tax revenue (code: 3890) is included in local revenue. Revenue codes used in this report can be found in the appendix.
- Enrollment figures include K5 through grade 12 and do not include 4-year-old students. Revenue figures may include funding for 4-year-old programs.
- Estimates are based on historical growth unless otherwise stated. Actual funding may vary.
- Federal funds for FY 2020-21, FY 2021-22, and FY 2022-23 include ESSER funds. FY 2023-24 also includes ESSER funds based on federal payments to districts from the South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE). FY 2024-25 includes estimates for ESSER funds based on data from SCDE.
- Estimates for FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25 contained in the report have been updated based on revised pupil and revenue data available as of September 13, 2024, unless otherwise specified, and are subject to change.
- FY 2024-25 pupil counts are based on the 45-day student count provided by SCDE.
- Actual revenue data are from the Statement of Revenues provided by SCDE.
- Districts that have consolidated over time are grouped.
- The Limestone Charter Association began in FY 2022-23.

Notes

- The FY 2022-23 Statement of Revenues for Clarendon and Jasper School Districts were not submitted by the districts. Revenue per pupil calculations do not include FY 2022-23 revenues for Clarendon and Jasper School Districts.
- The FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22 SC Public Charter School District Statement of Revenues provided to SCDE are restated to align the data with past reporting procedures. The revisions can be found in the appendix.
- The FY 2020-21 Charter Institute at Erskine Statement of Revenues provided to SCDE has been revised by the district. The revisions can be found in the appendix.
