

Over the long-run, employment is close to the trend prior to COVID


TOTAL NONFARM EMPLOYMENT IN SOUTH CAROLINA


SC Employment by Industry

UNEMPLOYED PERSONS PER JOB OPENING




State Fiscal Issues

After total state sales taxes, individual income tax is the second largest source of revenue for state appropriations


GENERAL FUND AND MAJOR OTHER FUND REVENUES

SOUTH CAROLINA GENERAL FUND, EIA, HEX, LOTTERY REVENUE


as a Percentage of Total Personal Income


Major Recipients of Budget Allocations – FY 2024-25 Over 60% of funding items provide aid to local governments and the public

ALLOCATION OF MAJOR FUNDING SOURCES - FY 2024-25




"New" Budget Funds by Fiscal Year FY 26 budget funds will be much lower than recent years

AVAILABLE "NEW" FUNDS BY BUDGET YEAR




General Fund – February 2025 Estimate

Collections are 9.7% above last year and \$510.9 million ahead of year-to-date expectations through March




Sales Tax - Actual vs. Estimate Growth has slowed following the pandemic run-up in collections and is expected to be 2.1% for FY 25


FY 2023-24 SOUTH CAROLINA EDUCATION LOTTERY SALES BY GAME TYPE


TRANSFERS TO SC EDUCATION LOTTERY ACCOUNTS



Personal Income Growth by County over the Past 10 Years Geographic dispersion of personal income varies significantly




Employment Growth by County over the Past 10 Years Geographic dispersion of job growth varies significantly

TOTAL EMPLOYMENT GROWTH BY COUNTY, 2014 TO 2024




Average Job Wage Growth by County over the Past 10 Years

Growth in Value of a Mill by County over the Past 10 Years Growth in property values varies widely across the state


VALUE OF A MILL - GROWTH FROM TAX YEAR 2012 to 2022


STATE AND LOCAL ACCOMMODATIONS AND HOSPITALITY TAXES – FY 2022-23


SC Population Pyramid

The age distribution of the state's population has shifted dramatically since 1970; the median age has increased from 24 in 1970 to 40 in 2020




SC 2030 Population Projections

The median age is expected to increase from 40 to 42 over the next decade; all baby boomers will be older than 65




South Carolina had the 10th Largest Population Increase in the US Population increased by 91,001 (1.7%) from 2023 to 2024





South Carolina Population, 2023




South Carolina In-Migration The majority of people moving to SC came from North Carolina and Georgia

MIGRATION INTO SOUTH CAROLINA, 2021 to 2022



South Carolina's Population Change, 2010 - 2020 Varied by county from +30.9% (Horry) to -23.4% (Allendale)




South Carolina's Population Change, 2020 - 2040 Varied by county from +68.6% (Horry) to -51.6% (Allendale)



South Carolina Births and Deaths, 1999 - 2022


The number of births remains relatively constant while deaths increased each year until 2022, surpassing births in 2020.









South Carolina's Components of Population Change 2022 - 2023




Statewide Age Trends

SC Population by Age Group – South Carolina Population in the 65 plus age range is projected to surpass the under 0-17 age range by 2027




SC Age 0 - 17 Population


Projected to decline to less than 20% of total population by 2040



South Carolina Age 0 – 17 Population Change, 2010 - 2020 Only nine counties increased in this age group




South Carolina Projected Age 0 – 17 Population, 2020 - 2040 Twelve counties are projected to increase in this age group



SC Workforce Population, Age 18 - 64

The workforce age population is expected to comprise a smaller percentage of the total SC population; employers may be faced with more demand for goods and services but a smaller pool of workers




Projected Impact of Aging Population

The declining percentage of workforce age population means there will be a relatively smaller pool, 208,000 people or 6%, to support the total population than in 2000


WORKFORCE AGE POPULATION COMPARISON, 2000 & 2030

Increase Needed to Maintain Ratio of Workforce to Population




SC Estimated Workforce Age (18 – 64) Population, 2010 – 2020 Fourteen counties increased in this age group




SC Estimated Workforce Age (18 – 64) Population, 2020 – 2040 Seventeen counties are projected to increase in this age group




SC Projected Age 65+ Population Projected to increase to over 22% of total population by 2040




SC Estimated Retirement Age (65+) Population, 2010 - 2020 All counties experienced an increase in this age group



SC Estimated Retirement Age (65+) Population, 2020 - 2040 Twenty-Six counties projected to increase in this age group




SC Bivariate Analysis of Population Migration and Age: 2022
