Paul Athey stated that as of now there is no timeline for issuance of the RFP, and David Morrison reiterated that all PSAPs would be asked for their input. Additionally, there was discussion regarding the best ways to ensure that feedback and recommendations are presented in a timely manner.
- Chair Burgess inquired about 911 Goes to Washington. Amy McDowell, Mitch Fulmer, and Sam Gaither stated the discussions focused on reclassification of Telecommunicators at a federal level and federal funding for NG911.

- Mitch Fulmore reminded the committee that the SC APCO/NENA Legislative Breakfast is schedule for May 8, 2025.
