

DESCRIPTION OF THE BOUNDARY OF THE
FEDERAL LAND BANK OF COLUMBIA (220-2)
GREENWOOD COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA.

All that certain tract or parcel of land, lying and being in Greenwood County, South Carolina, on the watershed of Mountain Creek, a tributary of Turkey Creek, and Savannah River, situate about two and one-half miles North of Boles Mountain, just East of U. S. Highway #25, and about four miles South of Kirksey, being covered by the following grants:

All bearings in this description are turned from the true meridian and all distances are expressed in chains.

This property is more particularly delineated on a map thereof, compiled by the U. S. Forest Service, Long Cane Purchase Unit, surveyed March 1935. said map being hereby declared to be part and parcel of this description.

Beginning at Corner ① a stake set alongside a stone at fence corner, old witnesses, common to R. H. Lanier tract and Bishop Peterson tract. A scribed 4" pine bears N. 60° W., 0.60 chain distant and a scribed 18" oak bears N. 51° 30' E., 0.43 chain distant.

Thence, N. 64° 50' W., (passing corner common to Bishop Peterson tract and Moses Senior tract), 31.2 chains to Corner 2, a stake set in center of old road, scribed bearing trees, identified by Moses Senior as the corner, common to Moses Senior tract, Mrs. Kate Self tract, and Mary Anderson tract.

Thence, two(2) lines with Mary Anderson tract, N. 1° 00' E., along old road, 3.5 chains to Corner 3, a stake in the center of said road, set from calls, scribed bearing trees; N. 10° 25' W., along road 5.3 chains to Corner 4, a stake at intersection of center of said road and the Eastern edge of right-of-way of U. S. Highway #25, (0.57 chain distant from centerline of said Highway), scribed bearing tree, common to Mary Anderson tract

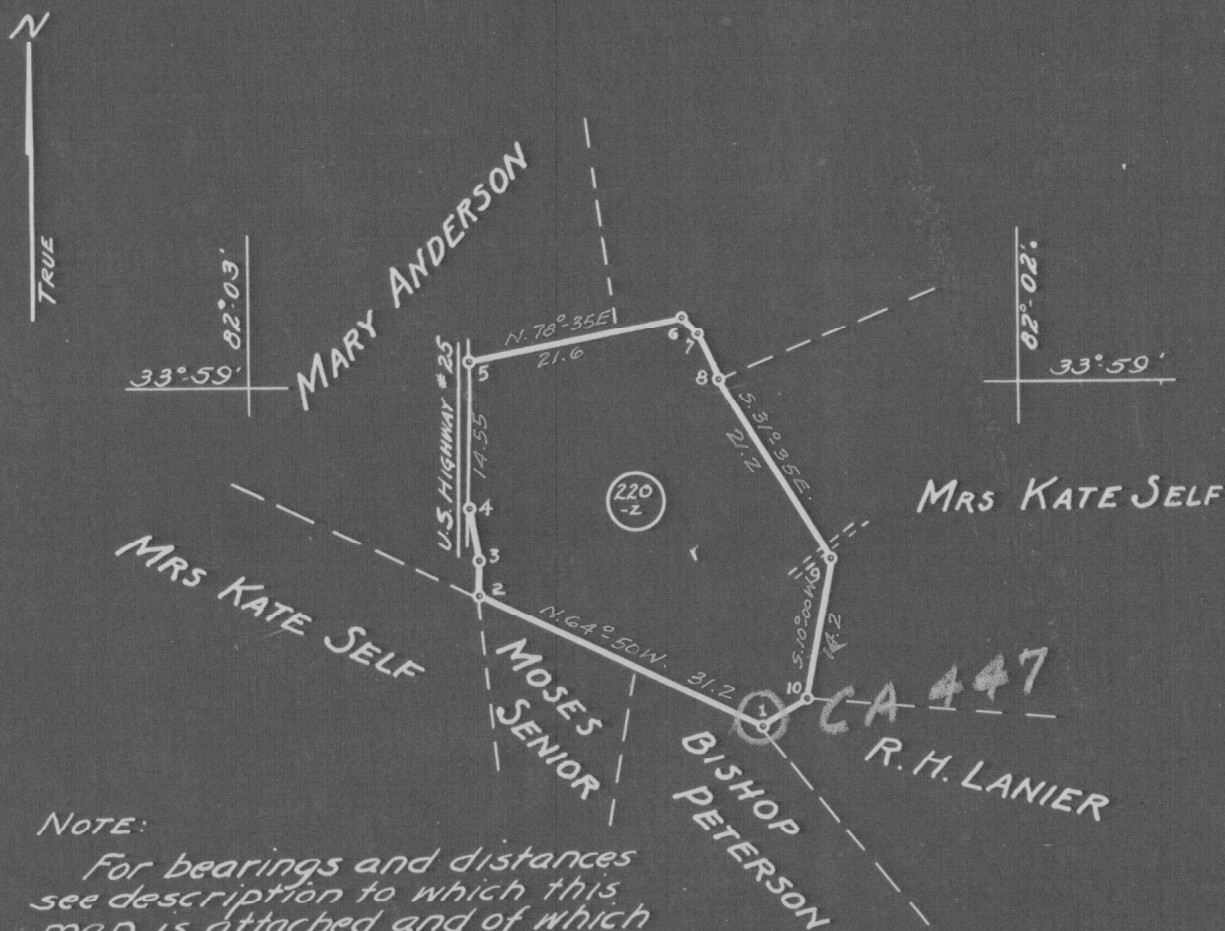
and U. S. Highway #25 Right-Of-Way tract.

Thence, in a Northernly direction, along and with Eastern edge of said Right-Of-Way tract, (0.57 chain distant from and parallel to centerline of said Highway), 14.55 chains to Corner 5, a stake on Eastern edge of said Right- Of-Way tract, set from calls, scribed bearing tree, common to said Right-Of-Way tract and Mary Anderson tract.

Thence, Three (3) lines with Mary Anderson tract, et al, N. 78° 35' E., along old hedgerow, (passing corner common to Mary Anderson tract, et al), 21.6 chains to Corner 6, a stake set in center of branch, old witnesses;
S. 44° 20' E., 2.25 chains to Corner 7, a 24" pine at bend in old fence;
S. 24° 05' E., along old blazed line, 4.9 chains to Corner 8, a stake set alongside a 24" ash in a bay, old witnesses, common to Mrs. Kate Self tract, et al.

Thence, two (2) lines with Mrs. Kate Self tract,
S. 31° 35' E., along hedgerow, 21.2 chains to Corner 9, a stake set alongside a wire fence and at intersection of two hedgerows;
S. 10° 00' W., 14.2 chains to Corner 10, a stake set alongside a mound of stones on rail fence line, common to Mrs. Kate Self tract and R. H. Lanier tract.

Thence, with R. H. Lanier tract,
S. 59° 30' W., 5.3 chains to the Place of Beginning containing ONE HUNDRED AND ONE AND FOUR-TENTHS (101.4) ACRES, be the same more or less.
