

DESCRIPTION OF THE BOUNDARY OF THE
I. B. STOCKMAN TRACT (218)
Greenwood and McCormick Counties, South Carolina

All that certain tract or parcel of land, lying and being in Greenwood and McCormick Counties, South Carolina, on the watershed of Cuffeytown Creek, a tributary of Stevens Creek and Savannah River, situate about 4 miles Southwest of Kirksey, about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles West of U. S. Highway #25, and about $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles Southeast of Callison, being covered by the following grants:

All bearings in this description are turned from the true meridian and all distances are expressed in chains.

This property is more particularly delineated on a map thereof, compiled by the U. S. Forest Service, Long Cane Purchase Unit, surveyed April 1935, said map being hereby declared to be part and parcel of this description.

All corners in the survey of this tract by the U. S. Forest Service were identified as such by Tom Hamilton.

Beginning at Corner 1, an 18" elm at the intersection of two hedgerows, common to Mrs. J. H. Self tract and I. B. Stockman tract. A scribed 8" oak bears S. 3° W., 0.14 chain distant and a scribed 4" pine bears S. 49° W., 0.09 chain distant.

Thence, two (2) lines with I. B. Stockman tract,
S. $53^{\circ} 30'$ E., 30.3 chains to Corner 2, a stake set at the intersection of two hedgerows;
N. $31^{\circ} 20'$ E., 20.7 chains to Corner 3, an 18" red oak at the intersection of two hedgerows, common to I. B. Stockman tract and John Williams tract.

Thence, with John Williams tract,
S. $41^{\circ} 10'$ E., 30.7 chains to Corner 4, a stake set alongside a large stone on old hedgerow, common to John Williams tract and

Mrs. J. H. Self tract.

Thence, three (3) lines with Mrs. J. H. Self tract,
S. 36° 05' W., 20.7 chains to Corner 5, a stake set alongside a
stone at the intersection of two hedgerows, old witness;
N. 54° 30' W., 24.7 chains to Corner 6, a 10" twin oak at the in-
tersection of two hedgerows;
S. 45° 00' W., 23.9 chains to Corner 7, a stake set on old hedgerow,
common to Mrs. J. H. Self tract and Henry Stockman tract.

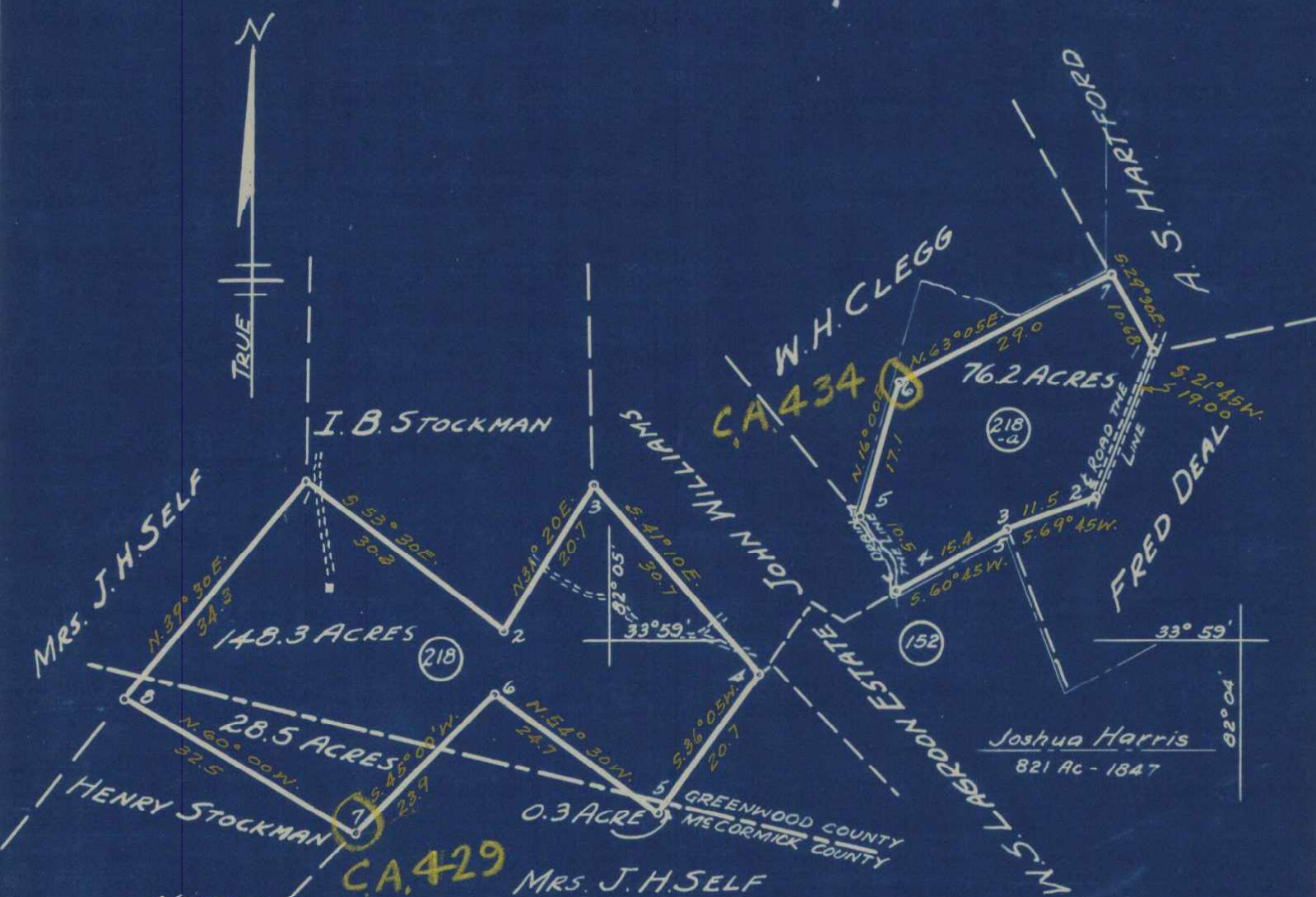
Thence, with Henry Stockman tract,
N. 60° 00' W., 32.6 chains to Corner 8, a stake set on old blazed
line, common to Henry Stockman tract and Mrs. J. H. Self tract.

Thence, with Mrs. J. H. Self tract,
N. 39° 30' E., 34.3 chains to the Place of Beginning, containing
ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN AND ONE-TENTH (177.1) Acres, be the
same more or less.
