All bearings in this description are turned from the true meridian and all distances are expressed in chains.

This property is more particularly delineated on a map thereof, compiled by the U. S. Forest Service, Long Cane Purchase Unit, surveyed February 1936, said map being hereby declared to be part and parcel of this description.

Beginning at Corner 1, a stake on the Northern edge of a road, set from sails, common to Eugene Walker tract and Henry Palmer tract. A scribed 12" pine bears N. 43° E., 0.11 chain distant and a scribed 8" pine bears N. 62° E., 0.43 chain distant.

Thence, N. 77° 30' W., (passing corner common to Henry Palmer tract and J. P. Harrison Estate tract) 29.3 chains to Corner (2), a stake set at the intersection of hedgerows, common to J. P. Harrison Estate tract.

Thence, with J. P. Harrison Estate tract, S. 11° 15' W., 7.7 chains to Corner 3, a stake set alongside a mound of stones, common to J. P. Harrison Estate tract and Jack Harrison tract.

37 Thence, with Jack Harrison tract, N. 37° 00' W., 40.0 chains to Corner 4, a point in the center of Cuffeytown Creek, old witness, common to Jack Harrison tract and George Dorn Estate tract.

Thence, in a general Northerly direction, up and with the meanders of Cuffeytown Creek, 23.1 chains to Corner 5, a stake set on the Eastern bank of Cuffeytown Creek, old witnesses, common to George Dorn Estate tract and G. C. Jordan tract.

Thence, with G. C. Jordan tract, N. 59° 30' E., 3.37 chains to Corner 6, a stake set at the intersection

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of a fence and a marked line, common to G. C. Jordan tract and D. L. Burnett tract.

S 58° 30' E Thence, with D. L. Burnett tract,  
S. 58° 30' E., 28.7 chains to Corner 7, a stake set on a marked line  
and on the Southern edge of a branch, common to D. L. Burnett tract and  
Eugene Walker tract.

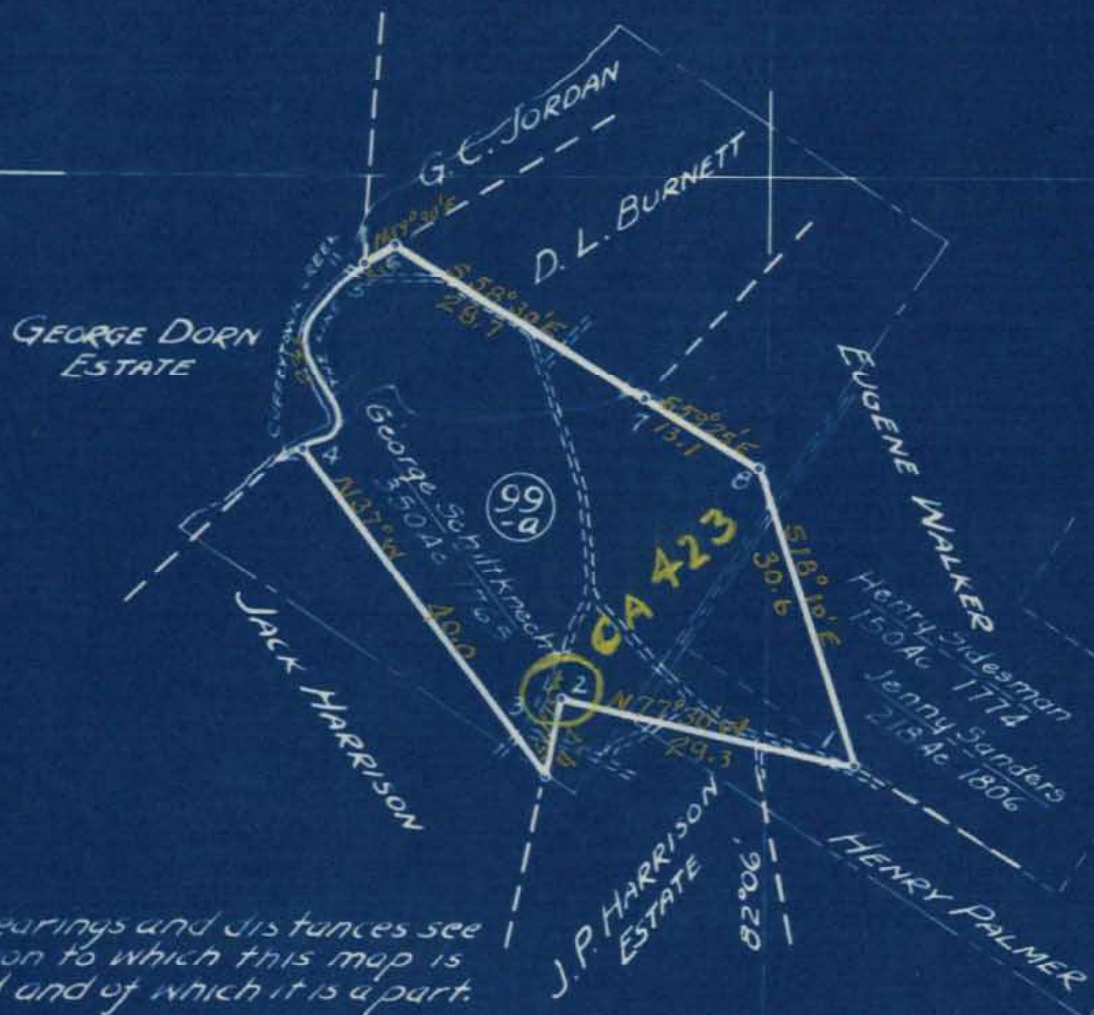
