Please note that the figures provided are estimates. Actual payments may vary.

- 1 - Pursuant to statute, population figures are based upon the most recent U.S. Census. Fifty cents per capita is withheld from the portion of the Local Government Fund allotted to counties for Medicaid services pursuant to §44-6-146. This amount totals \$2,559,212 for FY 2026-27.
- 2 - Estimates for FY 2025-26 are based upon recurring funds of \$305,896,242.
- 3 - Statutory formula estimates for FY 2026-27 are based upon the provisions of §6-27-30 with total funding of \$321,191,054. Actual payments will depend upon the amount appropriated by the General Assembly.
- 4 - Difference in the FY 2026-27 statutory formula estimate and the FY 2025-26 estimate.
