

The dotted line running from the 2^d corner to Stake 10th is the line of a tract of 111 acres granted to James M. Kelley the day of 20th January 1795 and appears to have been run by the said M. Kelley as a boundary for Mr. Sinkler from a subscription that his land extended no further from the river than the Santee Springs tract. But Mr. Sinkler being the prior grant of 111 acres to extend 44 chains further back than the Pine 3 x 0 m W (the last marked tree in the original plan) will give the dotted line without need for Mr. Sinkler's proper boundary and take from Mr. Phelps tract 111 acres from N 2 3, 45 acres.
